## A Letter from the President – FUJIFILM Recording Media U.S.A., Inc.’s Sustainability Efforts

February 2016

On behalf of FUJIFILM Recording Media U.S.A., Inc., I am pleased to let you know about our corporate commitment to social responsibility. At FUJIFILM Recording Media, one of our primary corporate goals is to enhance the quality of life for people worldwide, and our initiatives play an important role in that effort to preserve the surroundings in which we work and live.

**Solar Panel Project:** The solar panel installation project at our Bedford, Massachusetts manufacturing facility began in response to our overall corporate mission of energy conservation and Greenhouse gas reduction. With 1,870 modules, the solar installation produces about 644,000 kWh annually, which is equivalent to a reduction of 444 metric tons of carbon dioxide per year. Over 20 years, this would equal the carbon sequestered by 7,280 acres of U.S. forest in one year. Globally, Fujifilm has a Greenhouse gas target to reduce CO2 emissions by 30% by 2020.

**Vendors:** Our Supply Chain Department has also aligned FUJIFILM Recording Media with many vendors that complement our commitment to sustainability. Our pallet vendor is accredited by the Forest Stewardship Council® (FSC® C112029). They responsibly manage their sources while limiting clear cutting, preventing the loss of forest cover and protecting fragile forest ecologies. Our printing vendor uses Soy ink, a renewable resource, on all of our printed insert cards. Soy ink is biodegradable and requires less ink for the same amount of printing.

**Sustainable Materials:** We have recently sourced a more sustainable plastic for our Library Packs. The plastic is called DPET™\*. DPET has the lowest carbon footprint in the market. The facility we source it from uses 100% recycled wastewater. DPET requires 65% less energy to produce than conventional plastics.

With the installation of solar panels at our plant, environmentally minded improvements in our packaging, and in decisions at every level of our business, FUJIFILM Recording Media U.S.A., Inc. is consistently striving to become more sustainable.
